
The worldwide white grape par excellence provides a different nuance when grown in Castilian soil, bringing us this wonderful wine. A combination of typical sauvignon aromas are mixed with those of the land of Old Castile, such as red pepper and wood.

Sauvignon Blanc, with its unmistakable varietal characteristics, has a very pale straw yellow with a steely edge. With tropical aromas of green pineapple and mango on the nose, as well as boxwood and herbal tones with subtle citrus and red pepper as background notes. It has an excellent balance between volume, body and acidity in the mouth, with a lively and pleasant final bitterness that gives it excellent length.

Vineyard

The Bodeguilla estate, located in Valdecastillas in Valladolid, has several varieties of white grapes planted, one of which is Sauvignon Blanc, one of the most widely used for making white wines across the world. Planted on a trellis and at around 740 m above sea level, this plot has a sandy texture that makes it ideal for this type of variety. La Buitrera, in Pozaldez, is also planted on trellises, although in this case, the altitude at which it is located is higher, providing typical characteristics of the Sauvignon blend of this wine.

The young whites of Emina are characterised by an elegant tropical fruit in combination with tones of fennel.

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
