Altos de Tamarón Red is made from grapes of Tinta del País (Tempranillo) that are carefully selected from vines grown on gravelly, clay loam soils within the borders of Olmedillo de Roa, Burgos.

REGION

In the last 30 years, D.O. Ribera del Duero has emerged to challenge for the crown of Spain's greatest wine region. Located in Spain's northern plateau, it covers four of Castilla y León's provinces – Burgos, Segovia, Soria and Valladolid. But, unlike its name-sake, it does not cover all of the River Duero that unites more than 100 villages. Ribera del Duero was granted its D.O. in 1982. Today it has over 170 wineries and over 18,000 ha of vines. Most of Ribera del Duero's production is red with only a modest quantity of rosado produced. No white wines are allowed under the D.O. The region is characterised by a largely flat, rocky terrain.

TASTING NOTES

Deep cherry red with purple tones. On the nose, aromas of ripe blackberry and liquorice. The palate is silky and fruity with a long finish.

FOOD PAIRING

A perfect companion to grilled and braised meats, casseroles and pasta with red sauces.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

The grapes are carefully selected before embarking on a further 8-day maceration process to allow grape skin contact with the wine. They are fermented at a controlled temperature (22 °C) to ensure the optimum aromatic potential is obtained. This ensures that the wine acquires its characteristic colour and polished tannins. The bottles are then aged in our cellar for 4 months.
